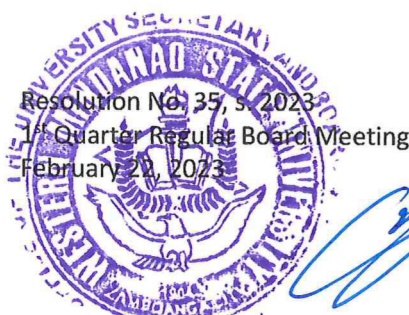

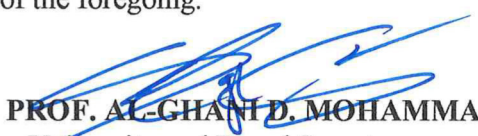
WHEREAS, the Board of Regents authorized the University to apply for the Certificate of Program Compliance (COPC) for the offering of BPA Program;
