RESOLUTION NO. 70 Series of 2023

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED REALIGNMENT OF UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM CURRICULA AND REVISED GRADUATE PROGRAM CURRICULA EFFECTIVE SCHOOL YEAR 2023-2024

WHEREAS, the Vice-President for Academic Affairs Dr. Nursia M. Barjose presented to the Board of Regents the proposal to be realigned the undergraduate program curricula and revised graduate program curricula;

WHEREAS, the University received a communication from the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) Central Office regarding the "Submission of Action Plan for SUCs to Comply with Rationalization of Programs and Certificate of Program of Compliance" dated February 27, 2023 which states, among others, that "SUCs are directed to rationalize their programs and course offerings to ensure that existing and proposed program offerings are within the core mandate of the SUC or under the fields of STEAM and compliant with CHED standards. Also, SUC Presidents and Officers-in-Charge are instructed to directly coordinate with concerned CHED Regional Directors to conduct an inventory of their program offerings, determine the status of their Certificate of Program Compliance (COPC), determine the alignment of the degree program with their mandates and prepare an action plan which will outline the necessary actions to rationalize program offerings and attain 100% COPC, pursuant to the Special Provision 2. Rationalization of State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) Programs and Course Offerings, Official Gazette, Vol. 118, No. 52, page 488 in the General Appropriations Act for FY 2023";
