





WHEREAS, the Fostering World Class Philippine Universities Project (International Rating and Benchmarking Using Internationalization Metrics as provided by QS Stars Rating System) is a CHED initiated project that aims to ramp up the internationalization initiatives of public universities;

- Faithfully observe the provisions of RA No. 9184, otherwise known as the An Act Providing for the Modernization, Standardization and Regulation of the Procurement Activities of the Government and for Other Purposes, and its implementing Rules and Regulations, if applicable;
- 9. Adhere to the prescribed accounting entries for booking up of property purchased out of the funds; and
- 10. At most, 5% of the program project cost shall be allocated for operation and administration, as per CHED Order No. 1 series of 2011 titled "Revised Guidelines on Allocation of the Higher Education Development Fund."
